Subject:- Adoption of Delhi pattern of grant-in-aid rules for
privately managed schools in Chandigarh -Payment of
grant-in-aid.

In pursuance of powers delegated under rule 12 of the
delegation of Financial Powers Rules, 1958, the Chief Commissioner,
Chandigarh Administration, is pleased to accord sanction to the
payment of on account grant of Rs. 41,117/- (Rupees forty one thousand
one hundred and seventeen only) to the p r ivately managed Govt. aided
institutions as detailed below:-

1. Guru Nanak Khalsa High School Sector 30, Chandigarh.	= Rs. 21,117/-
2. Sri Guru Gobind Singh High School, Sector 35, Chandigarh.	= Rs. 20,000/-
Total :	<u>Rs. 41,117/-</u>

The grant has been released on account of grant-in-aid
due to extension of pay scales of Govt. Schools Teachers under the
Chandigarh Administration to teachers working in privately managed
aided schools during the year 1975-76.

Grant may be drawn from the Treasury on the presentation
of bill duly countersigned by the Director Public Instruction,
Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh.

The expenditure involved is debitable to the head(s) of
account "277-Education-B.1(2)(3)-Assistance to Non Govt. Secondary
Schools-B.1(2)(3)(1)-Grant-in-aid (Non Plan)" during the year 1975-76

The grant is subject to following conditions:-

1. that the school shall abide by the grant-in-aid rules.
2. that the teachers are paid their salary by the management
by 7th of the following month for which it is due and
salary of the staff will be paid to the staff regularly.
3. that the annual increments are allowed and paid to the
staff regularly.
4. that the dearness allowance is paid to the staff at the
rates it is paid by the Chandigarh Admn. to its own employ
